2015 Accomplishments:


- We kept the community informed of local events with the monthly publication and distribution of approximately 1900 issues of *The Greater Hansville Log* and maintenance of the GHCC website, Hansville.org.
- We awarded \$5,000 in scholarships for promising high school graduates in the Greater Hansville Area.
- We introduced Tuesday Talks – a series of seven evening talks by local speakers on cultural, and scientific topics.
- We coordinated all aspects of the Annual Rummage Sale - a two-day event in August that raised over 40% of GHCC's operating funds and the Spring and Fall Book Sales.
- We produced a roster of seasonal events - namely the Pinewood Derby, Soup Night, St. Patrick's-Dinner, Easter Egg Hunt, the Red, White and Blue Pancake Breakfast, the Show n' Shine Car Show and Picnic in the Park, the Chili Cook-off, Octoberfest, the Wine

Social Children’s Christmas Party, New Year’s Eve Bingo Night and nine monthly Neighborhood Lunches.


- We provided a community meeting space by renting the West Room of GHCC for 21 private functions and 9 Garden Club meetings and the East Room for 178 events including computer and yoga classes and meetings of the Historical Society and the Hansville Greenway.
- We upgraded our generator to a Honeywell 17kw Standby model, enhancing our capacity as a Warming Station management and emergency response facility in coordination with the Kitsap and Olympic Peninsula Chapter of the American Red Cross in times of emergency.
